## **TIPS FOR REHOMING A FOUND PET**

1. Unfortunately, HSGS'S kennel is currently full to its maximum capacity and is unable to take in more pets at this time. Please know there is a limited number we can physically and financially provide and care for. We have very limited funds, as we are a donation funded only non-profit organization and do not receive tax funding of any kind.
2. As an alternative, you can try to contact other rescue organizations such as Paws and Claws (501-525-6594) or Guardian Angels Cat Club (501-623-3484). These are wonderful organizations, which you may check with for assistance regarding spaying/neutering or possibly a foster home to take the pet. If they cannot assist, as they have limits as well, we can provide low cost spay & neuter vouchers, which would cut the cost in half for altering the pet. These vouchers may be obtained from our Thrift Shop located at 2026 Central Avenue in the Freeman Shopping Center.
3. The Sentinel Record newspaper in Hot Springs will allow a 13-word ad for free to offer the pet up for adoption or list a "found" pet to try to find it's owner.
4. Once the pet is altered and current with its shots, you may send a digital picture and pet info (breed approx. age, etc.), to [jackie9@hughes.net](mailto:jackie9@hughes.net), we can post the pet on Petfinder or Craig's List offering it for adoption with your information as the contact.
5. Once the pet is altered and current on its shots, you can offer it up for adoption at Petco in the Cornerstone Shopping Center on Saturdays. You or its foster will sit with the pet and interview possible adopters to ensure the pet is going to a GOOD, RESPONSIBLE home.
