- 2) **I will keep this pet in a secure/fenced area.** _____ i.e.: **not allow pet loose/unsecured**
- 3) I will take the pet I am adopting to a licensed veterinarian within (14) working days of the adoption for a general "well pet" check up _____
- 4) I will **keep this pet current on all needed yearly vaccinations including rabies.** _____

- 5) I will always provide flea, tick, & heartworm preventions for this pet. _____
- 6) I am aware aforementioned preventions will cost hundreds of dollars yearly. _____
- 7) I will obey any/ all state & local laws/ordinances regarding this pet. _____
- 8) I will contact the HSGC (501-623-5012 or 276-3379) if this pet becomes missing. _____
- 9) I will **closely supervise this pet around children**, the actions of pets are unpredictable & their behavior may change while becoming acclimated to their new home. _____
- 10) I understand the Humane Society makes no claims or representations as to the behavior, health, temperament or training of pets put up for adoption and I hereby release the Humane Society of Garland County from all liability once the pet is fostered or adopted.

- 11) I will keep the pet (s) I adopt as my household pet/companion pet only _____
- 12) If I am unable to care for the pet (s) in the future, I will notify/set up the return of the pet (s) to The Humane Society of Garland County. _____
- 13) I will not sell, trade, transfer ownership, abandon or dispose (euthanize) of this pet (s) in any way, nor release the pet (s) to any one. _____
- 14) I understand the Humane Society does not adopt or foster out pets to be put on chains. I will not chain this pet (s) Federal law 1997 prohibition AWA. _____ **A secure, fenced yard is required for dogs outside.**
- 15) A fenced yard is not required for dogs staying indoors, they may be put on runners for short periods of time if supervised (maximum time of thirty minutes) _____
- 16) I will not de-claw or physically alter (ear/tail crop) this pet for non-medical reasons _____

17) I understand the Humane Society of Garland County views declawing surgeries as inhumane & for human convenience only. The pet has a painful recovery from amputation of the claw and the first knuckle of a cat's toes, then has no protection if outside. _____

18) For **Health and Safety** reasons the Humane Society of Garland County **does NOT adopt** cats/kittens to parties seeking an outside cat/kitten. I will keep pet inside only. _____

19) I understand **that any failure to comply with the foregoing agreement will constitute a breach of contract**; in the event of such breach of contract, I hereby **authorize the Adoptee (HSGC) to reclaim both possession and ownership of the adopted pet.** _____

H.S.G.C. adult dogs are heartworm free & on heartworm & flea/tick prevention, have been de-wormed for hooks, whips, and rounds had 5 way & rabies vaccination.

H.S.G.C. adult cats have been tested for feline leukemia & FIV (feline immunodeficiency virus) have had 3 way vaccination & rabies vaccine, flea/tick prevention & also have been de-wormed for rounds & hooks.

Liquidation Damages Clause

I agree to pay the Humane Society of Garland County the sum of \$250.00 as liquidated damages in the event the terms of this contract are breached. The liquidated damage value is agreed to for the purpose of establishing the value of the pet and in no way bars the Humane Society from seeking return of the animal by legal means. attorney's fees and court cost in the event this matter is forwarded to an attorney for enforcement
